ID4Africa - the 1st Government Forum on Electronic Identity in Africa was held on 2-4 June 2015 at the Serena Dar es Salaam Hotel in Tanzania. The forum was hosted by the National Identification Authority (NIDA) of the Ministry of Home Affairs of Tanzania and organised by APSCA and the Identity Counsel International.

This inaugural event produced outstanding results which surpassed all expectations in providing a united platform on which delegates from over 50 nations gathered to discuss pressing issues, share knowledge, experiences, best practices and learn more about cutting-edge technologies and solutions for the development of digital identity in Africa and its applications for driving socio-economic development.

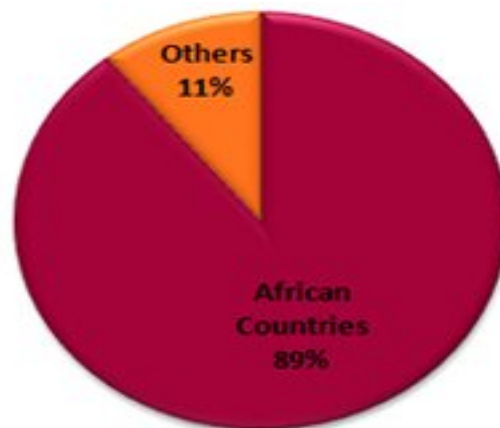
100 SENIOR GOVERNMENT REPRESENTATIVES FROM 43 NATIONAL AGENCIES
